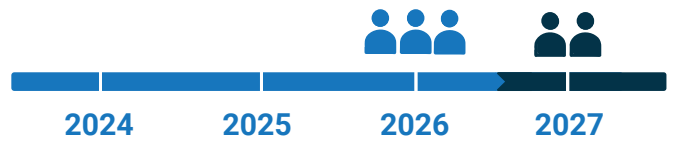

What you need to know

ADA Title II mandates **WCAG 2.1 A/AA** standards for digital accessibility.

Deadline: **2 or 3 years**, depending on population size.



Who needs to comply

US State and Local Governments:

- All US states
- All US territories

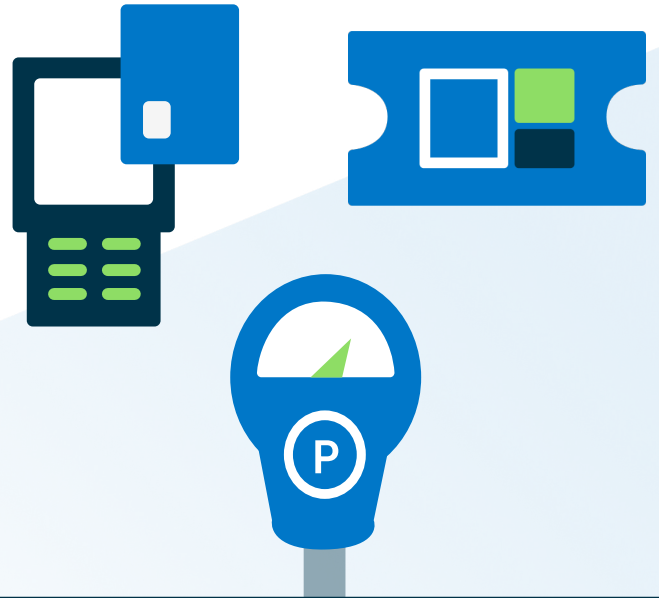
Third-Party Vendors:

Any companies providing digital services to, or on behalf of, US state and local governments.

Impact on third-party vendors

Some examples of affected services:

- Parking payment apps
- Website template providers
- Payment processors
- State lotteries
- Event ticketing services
- Educational technology providers
- Health service platforms
- Public service applications



5 steps to achieve compliance

- 1 Conduct comprehensive accessibility audits.
- 2 Train all relevant teams.
- 3 Embed accessibility in design and development.
- 4 Partner with accessibility experts.
- 5 Monitor and maintain accessibility.

- Online purchasing of tickets
- Access to public records

- Public health and safety information
